# Transportation & Finances

- A **registration deposit** of \$50 per person is required. The deposit fee may be waived for those traveling by car.
- No **airline ticket** will be purchased without receipt of the registration deposit. This registration deposit is **non-refundable** if an airline ticket has been purchased.
- DBTS is conveniently located just 15 minutes from the **Detroit airport** (DTW).
- The **student is responsible** for getting a ride to his local airport and for meals purchased in transit.
- **DBTS will cover** all other expenses related to transportation, housing, meals, and activities.
- **DBTS will not be liable** for transportation costs incurred apart from the registration process.
- **Reimbursement** will be available on an actual expense basis (receipts required) for those electing to drive their personal vehicle to Seminary Days.
