MORE GREAT WAYS TO VISIT DBTS

- **Test Drive** is a tuition-free summer school class for credit for serious prospective students. Six classes are offered in three two-week sessions (mid-May through June). The summer school class schedule is posted to the website in January.
- **Mid-America Conference on Preaching** is held on the third Thursday-Friday of October. Media resources from past conferences are posted on the website. Travel expenses are covered by DBTS.



SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

WEDNESDAY

- Afternoon/Evening—travel

THURSDAY

- Morning—attend classes and chapel
- Afternoon—lunch with the faculty; tour of church, bookstore, schools

FRIDAY

- Morning—attend classes
- Afternoon—lunch with staff and students; cultural/recreational activity
- Evening—dinner with faculty, staff, students; cultural/recreational activity

SATURDAY (optional extension)

- Daytime—Vision Tour (WSU campus, urban and Arab ministry opportunities, and downtown Detroit, plus housing & employment options
- Evening—dinner and free time

SUNDAY (optional extension)

- Morning—worship at Inter-City Baptist Church
- Afternoon—dinner out; travel

TRANSPORTATION & FINANCES

- DBTS is conveniently located just 15 minutes from the Detroit airport (DTW).
- A small registration deposit is required prior to purchasing an airline ticket. The deposit fee will be waived for those traveling by car.
- The student is responsible for getting a ride to his local airport and for meals purchased in transit.
- DBTS will cover all other expenses related to transportation, housing, meals, and activities.
- Reimbursement will be available on an actual expense basis for those electing to drive their personal vehicle to Seminary Days.

Seminary Days events are planned annually for college juniors and seniors, and those in graduate school, normally during the month of March. The program is held on Thursday through Friday, with the option of staying over for Saturday and Sunday.
