Mid-America Conference on Preaching

Each fall Inter-City Baptist Church and Detroit Baptist Theological Seminary host the Mid-America Conference on Preaching. MACP is planned to encourage and equip those who preach God's Word to His people within the local church. The work of preaching is always an annual emphasis. However, each year we also focus on an important doctrinal and ministry issue.

This year we are focusing on "Church Growth that Glorifies God." This area of ministry today is greatly abused or sadly neglected by various groups within professing Christianity. The general sessions and workshops will examine the theological foundation for personal evangelism and missions and review a biblical philosophy of ministry, especially as it relates to the contemporary church growth movement. Practical instruction on church planting will be provided by several men who have been, or are now, actually engaged in the task as pastors. We invite you to join us for a time of thorough Bible study and fervent preaching on these great truths and our necessary response to them.

A Special Note for Prospective Students

We encourage men who are considering ministry training to visit Detroit Baptist Theological Seminary during the Mid-America Conference on Preaching. It provides a valuable time of instruction, fellowship with pastors who are attending the conference, and an opportunity to see the seminary in person. Prospective students are encouraged to attend classes on Wednesday prior to the conference and to participate in a special luncheon with the faculty on Friday. A seminary representative will be available throughout the conference to answer your questions and provide assistance as needed.

For those students attending MACP the registration fee will be waived. Students traveling from outside the metro Detroit area may receive help with the cost of transportation and lodging, as well as meals while in Detroit.
